3. DOCUMENTS TO BE INCLUDED WITH APPLICATION

- □ MLPAO Out of Province PLA Application Form
- □ An academic credentials assessment must be provided by all applicants who received their education outside of Canada
- PLA Experience Verification Form Experience that includes a minimum of 20 successful phlebotomy procedures within the past 24 months, ECG experience (preferred), and 80 hours of practical experience in a licensed clinical laboratory. This form must be signed by the laboratory director, supervisor, or delegate as proof of completion.
- □ Current resume
- □ Letter from your current and/or past employer(s) stating the position held, length of time in the position and a list of duties performed
- □ A copy of all certificates, diplomas, degrees, transcripts, and course outlines (if available) from education completed in the science field
