

MLPAO MLA/T and MLT Early Career Bursary

One MLPAO bursary of \$1500 is awarded to a recent graduate of an MLA/T or MLT program in Ontario.

Eligibility

An applicant must meet the following criteria in order to be eligible:

- be a certified MLA/T or registered MLT member of the MLPAO
- graduated from an MLA/T or MLT program in Ontario within the last 16 months
- be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or landed immigrant

Selection Criteria

The following criteria are considered in determining a recipient:

- The applicant can demonstrate a personal commitment to the profession through leadership or significant participation in educational or community activities.
- The applicant must demonstrate strong academic and practical aptitude in their program with at least a 75% overall average upon gradutation.
- The applicant submits a completed application form along with all the required documents by the application deadline.

Application Requirements

- 1. Completed MLPAO Early Career Bursary Application
- 2. An academic transcript issued from the school that shows final course marks with upper level of standing in the class and under no condition be less than 75%.
- 3. Copy of MLPAO certification for MLA/T graduates or copy of CSMLS certificate for MLT graduates
- 4. An original letter (500 600 words) from the applicant to the MLPAO Bursaries Selection Committee describing:
 - a. their personal commitment to the profession through leadership or significant participation in educational or community activities;
 - b. how they would benefit from the bursary including a description of how the bursary will help to jumpstart their career and,
 - c. any special circumstances to be considered by the Selection Committee.

Deadline for application submission is February 28. Any incomplete and/or late applications will be disqualified.
