70% of labs were severely understaffed going into this pandemic¹ and after performing 28+ million COVID-19 tests on top of 280+ million other tests (annually), it's understandable that 90% of medical laboratory professionals are experiencing burnout.²

According to the CDC, 70% of medical decisions rely on laboratory results. Medical laboratories impact all aspects of patient care, from emergency rooms to family medicine to mental health. Every sample, from blood drawn in doctors' offices to tumours extracted during surgery, is processed, and analyzed by an MLT.
